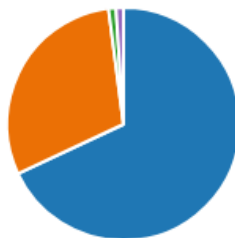

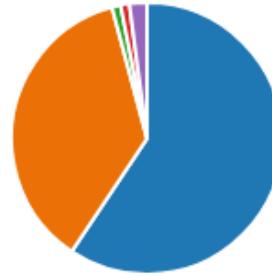

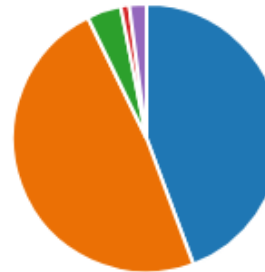

The clubs are difficult to book when your a working parent quite often they have all gone and it leave my children upset that they have not got a single club when many others have multiple.

The language in the playground and entrance/exit areas is disgusting from both parents and children and not addressed. School rules are constantly ignored. My child is bullied often and nothing ever seems to change despite it being raised. I am increasingly concerned about their mental health because of the bullying and send needs.

More after school clubs that aren't sport ones.

I think more support could be put in place for children struggling with the classroom.

The booking system for after school club is not fairly done especially when working parents unable to access the system. Then some children have multiple clubs whilst others have none

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The only negative i find is that working in a school myself when it comes to.booking clubs from my children i feel they always miss out as the booking usually goes open at 12 which is no good as by the time i get on everything is unavailable and my child missing out. I understand that some parents work evening so its tricky .

When I have raised concern about a student my child have a problem with, I find it's not dealt with how I would have expected and although they are aware they don't get on, my child keeps being put with that kid in proud and made to sit next to him sometimes.
