

# KILVE COURT



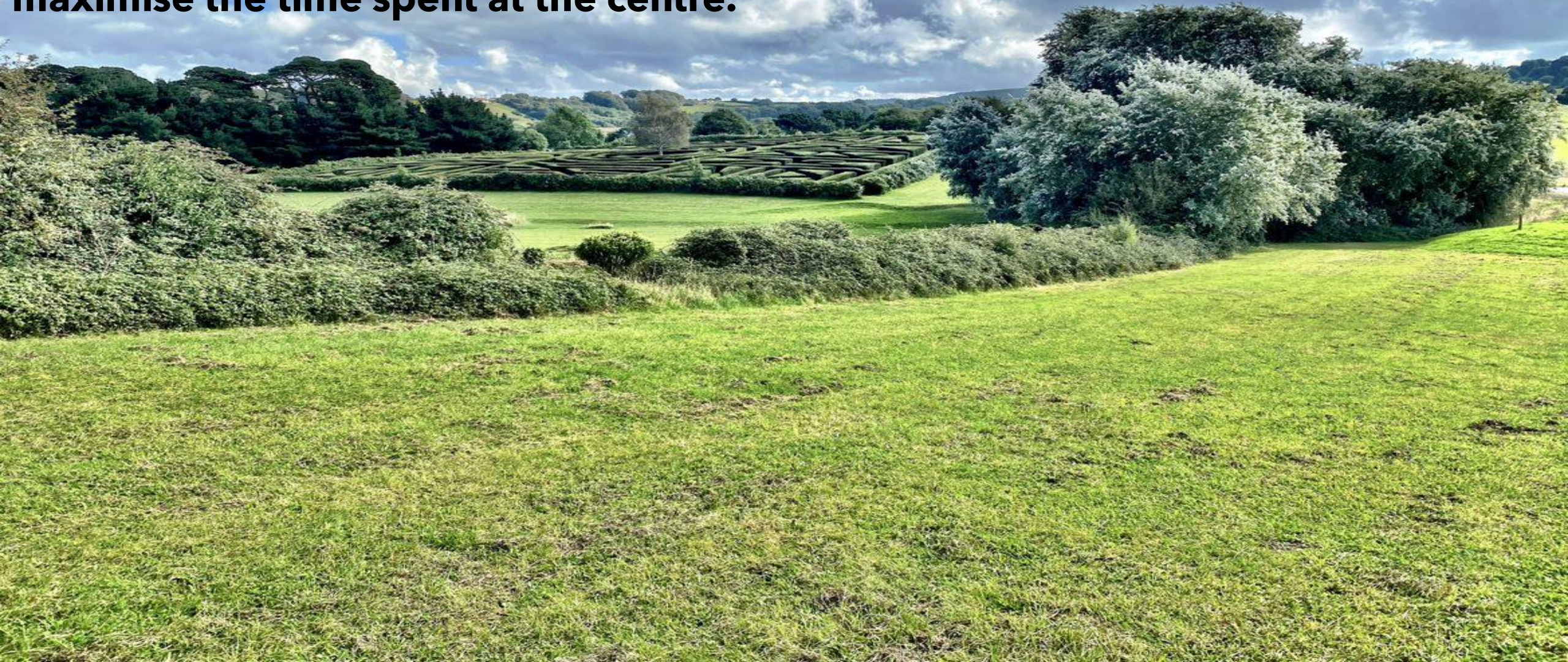
**Kilve Court is a Georgian country house with modern extensions.**

**The centre is set in 40 acres of landscaped gardens and wooded grounds, on the northern edge of the Quantock *Hills* (an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty), and only one mile from the sea.**



**The centre offers a range of exciting and challenging activities in a safe and supportive environment.**

**The visit is tailor made to the schools requirements and activities are organised to maximise the time spent at the centre.**



Children are accompanied by teaching staff and all the activities are run by highly experienced and trained staff at the centre.

When not in a structured session, children are supervised by teaching staff.

The centre continually carries out safety and risk assessments on all the equipment and apparatus needed to carry out any of the activities.



# Accommodation



Each school group has its own **secure, separate sleeping accommodation** block.

Room sizes vary from twins to large dormitories sleeping 12.



Toilets and showers on each corridor and sinks in each room.

Keypad entry to all accommodation blocks.  
Separate staff accommodation on each floor.



Pupils bring their own sleeping bags and/or duvets.

Kilve has a Duty Manager on site 24/7.

# The most important bit...food!



- **BREAKFAST** - A choice of cereal, followed by a cooked breakfast, with fruit juice & toast.
- **LUNCH** - A choice of 2 cooked meals, jacket potatoes, filled rolls and a fresh salad bar. Fruit for dessert.
- **DINNER** - 2 choices, one of which is vegetarian, a salad bar and a pudding!
- **BREAK TIMES** - Squash, biscuits, fruit or cake

**All dietary requirements** are catered for – we just need to know these in advance. No one goes hungry!

While on residential, the children can expect:

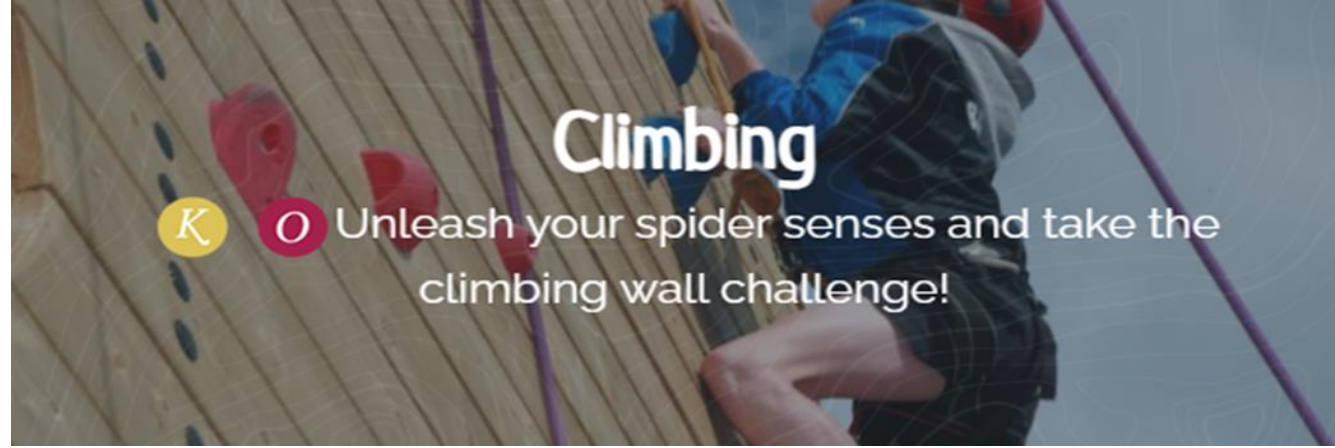
- **To gain new skills and increase confidence.**

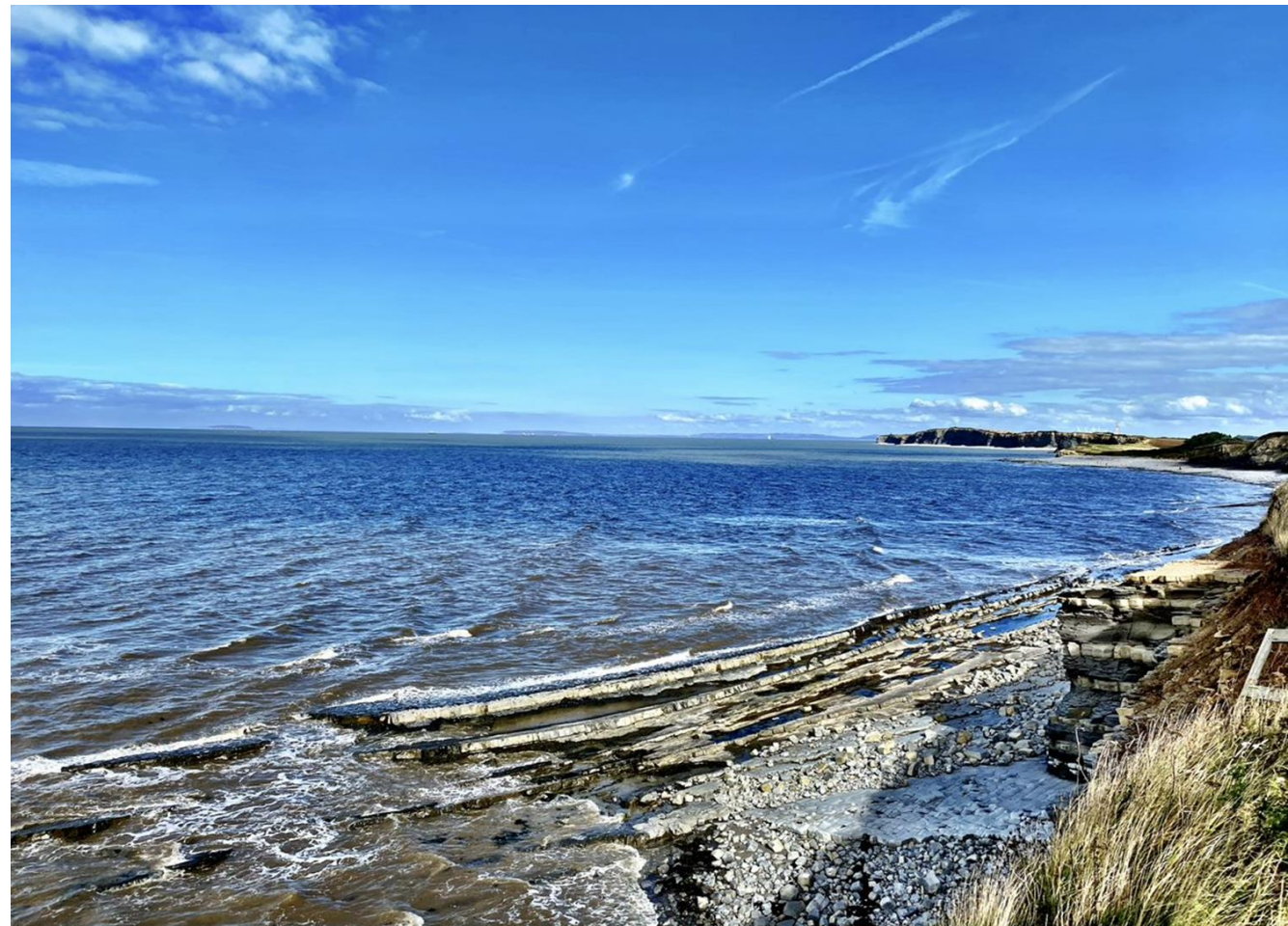

# Financial Details

**WEDNESDAY 16<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2026 to FRIDAY 18<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2026.**

Children will leave school on the Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> at 10.00 and travel to Kilve Court by coach. We will return to school by 3.00 on Friday 18<sup>th</sup>.

**The price of the residential is £270.00.**

This cost includes: Travel to and from the centre by coach; Accommodation ; All activities and courses (led by qualified and specialized instructors) and All meals (breakfast, lunch, evening meal).

To confirm your child's place on the residential, consent and an initial deposit of **£50 will be required by 1<sup>st</sup> December 2025**. The total cost of the trip can either be paid in full or by installments if you wish. All payments must be made using SCOPAY. If you experience problems using Scopay, please contact a member of the school office for assistance.

**Final payments MUST be made by 1<sup>st</sup> August 2026** to ensure a place on the residential. Any requests made to attend AFTER this date will depend availability of accommodation at Kilve Court. A waiting list will be set up in this case.

**All deposits are non-refundable.**

**Booking will open on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> November at 9.30am on SCOPAY.**
